

DESIGN FOR A PENCIL OR THE LIKE

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, David Kahn, a citizen of the United States, residing at Woodcliff, in the county of Hudson and State of New Jersey, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Pencil or the like, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing forming a part thereof, wherein—

Figure 1 is a partial perspective showing my new design, said perspective being taken when the pencil has been rotated in a clockwise direction from the position shown in Figure 2 to show only the silhouette of the left hand panel and more completely show the right hand panel.

Figure 2 is a front elevational view of the pencil showing the lower center panel and the

adjacent right and left hand lower side panels.

Figure 3 is an elevational view taken when the pencil has been rotated to bring the complete side panel to the frontal position.

Figures 4, 5 and 6 are transverse sectional views on the lines 4—4, 5—5 and 6—6 of Figure 2, respectively.

The dominant feature of my design resides in the finger gripping member having diagonally opposed elliptically shaped concave surfaces, the faces between said surfaces being elongated and flaring outwardly at its extremities.

I claim:

The ornamental design for a pencil or the like, as shown and described.
