DESIGN FOR A FOUNTAIN PEN

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that we, Peter Schladermundt and Olive Emslie, citizens of the United States and residents of Bronxville, in the county of Westchester and State of New York, and New York city, in the county and State of New York, respectively, have invented the new, original, and ornamental Design for a Fountain Pen, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof, in which—

Figure 1 is a front elevational view of a fountain pen showing our new design.

Fig. 2 is a view at right angles.

The dominant features of our design reside in the pen cap and particularly in the design of the clip and in the manner in which the clip is recessed into the cap and also in the curvature of the cap and barrel, all longitudinal lines thereof when the fountain pen is closed being uninterrupted curved lines extending from the top of the cap to the bottom of the barrel.

We claim:
