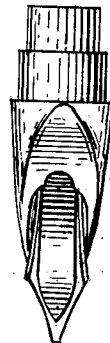

**DESIGN FOR A WRITING TIP SECTION OF A
FOUNTAIN PEN**

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Joseph Tully, a subject of the King of Great Britain, residing at the city of Toronto, in the county of York, in the Province of Ontario, Dominion of Canada, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Writing Tip Section of a Fountain Pen, of which the following is the specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.

Figure 1 is a plan view of the writing tip section showing my new design.

Figure 2 is a side elevation thereof, and Figure 3 is a bottom plan view thereof.
