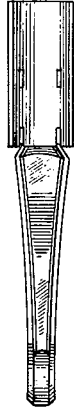

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, David Kahn, a citizen of the United States, residing at Woodcliff, in the county of Hudson and State of New Jersey, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Fountain Pen and Pencil Initial Clip, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing forming a part thereof, wherein:—

Figure 1 is a front elevational view of a foun-

tain pen and pencil initial clip showing my new design;

Figure 2 is a rear elevational view thereof; and

Figure 3 is a side elevational view.

Figure 4 is a top plan view of the clip.
