

DESIGN FOR A FOUNTAIN PEN

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Wilbur K. Olson, a citizen of the United States and a resident of Fort Madison, in the county of Lee and State of Iowa, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Fountain Pen, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming a part thereof.

Fig. 1 is a front elevational view of a fountain pen, showing my new design with the writing point covered; and

Fig. 2 is a side elevational view with the writing point exposed.

The dominant features of my design reside in the contour of the cap shown in full lines, the outer walls of which are characterized by continuous curved lines, a band of contrasting color being disposed at the open end thereof, all as illustrated.

I claim:

The ornamental design for a fountain pen, substantially as shown and described.
