


## DESIGN FOR A FOUNTAIN PEN

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Charles T. Breitenstein, a citizen of the United States and a resident of Chicago, in the county of Cook and State of Illinois, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Fountain Pen, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming a part thereof.

Figure 1 is a side elevational view of a fountain pen showing my new design with the writing end covered.

Figure 2 is a front elevation with the cap in disassembled relation to the body of the pen and rotated 90 degrees from the position illustrated in Fig. 1.

The ornamental design for a fountain pen, substantially as shown and described.
