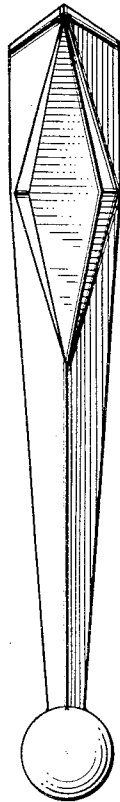
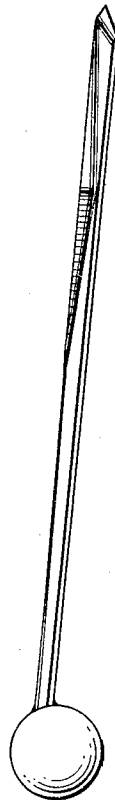

DESIGN FOR A FOUNTAIN-PEN CLIP OR SIMILAR ARTICLE

Application filed December 31, 1930. Serial No. 38,159. Term of patent 14 years.

*To all whom it may concern:*

Be it known that I, HARRY ESTEROW, a citizen of the United States, and a resident of the city, county, and State of New York, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Fountain-Pen Clip or Similar Article, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming a part hereof, in which—

Figure 1 is a front elevation of a fountain pen clip or similar article, showing my new design; and
