

DESIGN FOR A FOUNTAIN PEN

Application filed February 9, 1932. Serial No. 42,796. Term of patent 7 years.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Herbert L. Carman, a subject of Great Britain, and resident of 243 West 17th Street, borough of Manhattan, city, county and State of New York, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Fountain Pen, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawings, forming part thereof.

Figure 1 is an elevation showing the cap as shown and described. covering the pen point of the fountain pen.

Figure 2 is an elevation showing the cap on the barrel when the fountain pen is in use.

Figure 3 is an enlarged cross-section on line 3—3, Figure 2, through the cap, only showing its decagon shape, and

Figure 4 is an enlarged cross-section on line 4—4, Figure 2 of the barrel, showing only its decagon shape.
