


DESIGN FOR A PENCIL LEAD CONTAINER OR THE LIKE

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, David Kahn, a citizen of the United States, residing at Woodcliff, in the county of Hudson and State of New Jersey, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for Pencil Lead Containers or the like, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming a part thereof, wherein:

Fig. 1 is a side elevation of the pencil lead container showing my new design;

Fig. 2 is a side elevation of the pencil lead

container with the cap in a telescoped position; Fig. 3 is a bottom plan view of the pencil lead

container member only;

Fig. 4 is a side elevation of the cap member enlarged to show the cap design; and

Fig. 5 is a plan view of the cap member.
