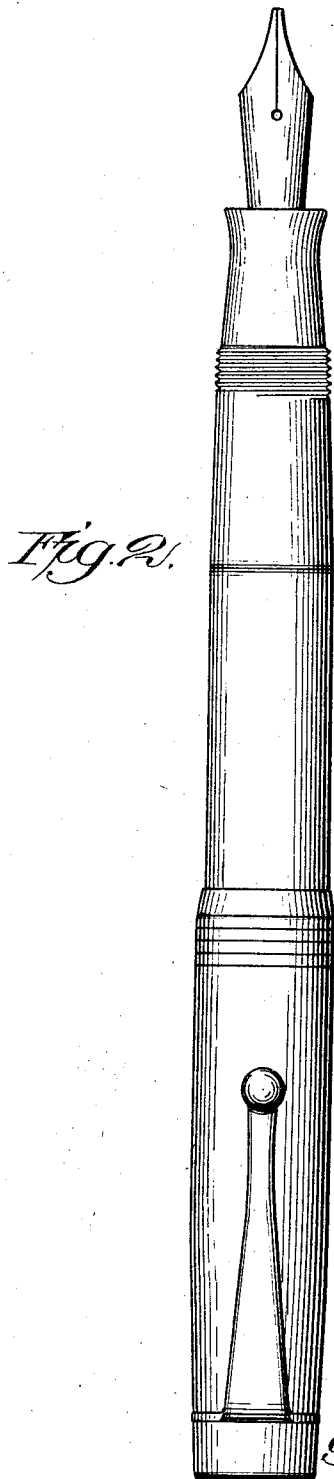
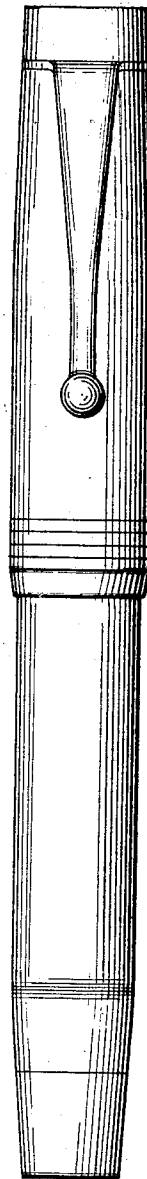

DESIGN FOR A FOUNTAIN PEN

Application filed July 8, 1929. Serial No. 31,965. Term of patent 14 years.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, KENNETH S. PARKER, a citizen of the United States, residing at Janesville, county of Rock, State of Wisconsin, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for Fountain Pen, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming a part thereof.

In the drawing,—

Figure 1 is a plan view of a fountain pen, showing my new design;

Figure 2 is a view similar to Figure 1 showing the cap positioned on the end of the barrel opposite the writing point of the pen.
