DESIGN FOR A FOUNTAIN PEN

Application filed January 16, 1931. Serial No. 38,323. Term of patent 14 years.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, ANDREAS BIENENSTEIN, a citizen of the United States of America, residing at Toledo, in the county of Lucas and State of Ohio, have invented a new, original and ornamental Design for Fountain Pen, and of which the following is a specification, reference being had therein to the accompanying drawings, forming a part thereof, wherein—

Figure 1 is an elevational view of a fountain pen showing my new design with the cap removed from the pen end and applied to the other end;

Figure 2 is a similar view showing the cap applied to the pen point end; and

Figure 3 is an enlarged top or bottom end view.

The essential or dominant feature of my new design consists in the combination of the contour of the fountain pen with the series of longitudinally extending circumferentially arranged flat surfaces providing panels on the outer surface of the fountain pen barrel and cap, these panels terminating short of the ends of the barrel and cap, respectively.

I claim:

The ornamental design for a fountain pen substantially as shown and described.
