

DESIGN FOR A FOUNTAIN PEN NIB

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Norman E. Weigel, a citizen nib showing my new design, and of the United States and a resident of Short Hills, in the county of Essex and State of New Jersey, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Fountain Pen Nib, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part as shown and described. thereof.

Figure 1 is a top plan view of a fountain pen

Figure 2 is a side elevation thereof.

The portion ${\bf I}$ of the nib is of gold color, while the portion 2 is of platinum or steel color.
