DESIGN FOR A CLIP FOR A FOUNTAIN PEN OR SIMILAR ARTICLE

Application filed April 26, 1930. Serial No. 35,402. Term of patent 7 years.

*To all whom it may concern:*

Be it known that I, LOUIS MORRISON, a citizen of the United States of America, residing at New York city, county and State of New York, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Clip for a Fountain Pen or Similar Article, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing forming part hereof, in which—
