

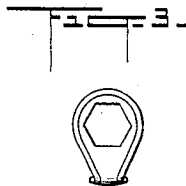
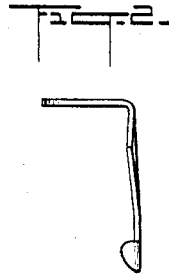
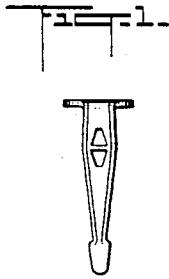

DESIGN FOR A CLIP FOR PEN OR SIMILAR ARTICLE

Application filed March 21, 1932. Serial No. 43,250. Term of patent 14 years.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, GABRIEL LARSEN, a citizen of the United States, residing at Springfield, in the county of Union and State of New Jersey, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for Clip for Pen or Similar Article, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming a part thereof, in which:

Fig. 1 is a face view of the clip.

Fig. 2 is a side view of the clip taken at right angles to the view of Fig. 1.

Fig. 3 is a top view of the clip.
