

DESIGN FOR A CLASP FOR FOUNTAIN PEN OR SIMILAR ARTICLE

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Raymond Loewy, a citizen of the United States, residing at New York, in the county of New York and State of New York, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Clasp for Fountain Pen or Similar Article, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming a part thereof.

In the drawing:

Fig. 1 is a side elevational view of a clasp for fountain pen or similar article embodying my new design;

Fig. 2 is a front elevational view of same; Fig. 3 is a side perspective view of same; and Fig. 4 is a top view of same.
