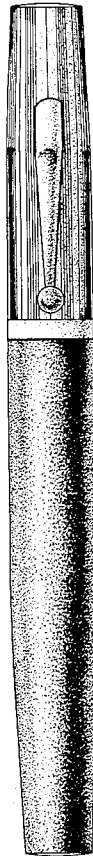
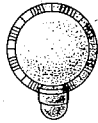

*To all whom it may concern:*

Be it known that I, Arthur Winter, a citizen of the United States and a resident of Weehawken, in the county of Hudson and State of New Jersey, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Fountain Pen or Similar Article, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.

Figure 1 is an end view of a fountain pen showing my new design.

Figure 2 is a side elevation of the pen.

The essential feature of my design resides in ornamenting the cap and barrel portions of a fountain pen or similar article by means of contrasting colors as shown.
