

DESIGN FOR A FOUNTAIN PEN

Application filed June 18, 1929. Serial No. 31,743. Term of patent 14 years.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, George Coby, a citizen of the United States of America, residing at Pawtucket, county of Providence, State of Rhode Island, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Fountain Pen, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming a part thereof.

Fig. 1 is an elevation showing the cap as covering the end of the body in which the pen point is mounted; Fig. 2 is an elevation showing the cap as applied to the end of the body opposite to that of the pen point; Fig. 3 is a section on line 3—3 of Fig. 2, showing

the triangular shape of the cap; Fig. 4 is a section on line 4—4 of Fig. 2, showing the correspondingly triangular shape of the body; Fig. 5 is a section on line 5—5 of Fig. 2, showing the triangular shape of the tapered portion between the body portion and the pen point; and Fig. 6 is a section on line 6—6 of Fig. 2 and shows the circular shape of the end of the body beyond the triangular portion thereof of a fountain pen, showing my new design.

I claim:

The ornamental design for a fountain pen, substantially as shown and described.
