To whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, CHARLES K. LOVEJOY, a citizen of the United States, residing at Roslindale, in the county of Suffolk and State of Massachusetts, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Pencil Clip or Similar Article, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.

The drawing is a perspective view of a pencil clip or similar article, showing my new design.

The essential feature of the invention is found in the low tip portion of the clip, where, on the out-face, the representation is that of a jewel or a simulation of a jewel.

I claim:

The ornamental design for a pencil clip or similar article as shown and described.
