

DESIGN FOR A FOUNTAIN PEN

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Charles K. Lovejoy, a citizen of the United States, residing at Needham, in the county of Norfolk and State of Massachusetts, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Fountain Pen, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.

In the drawing:

Figure 1 is a front elevational view of a fountain pen, showing my new design;

Figure 2 is a front elevational view thereof, as it appears when ready for use; and

Figure 3 is a side elevational view of the cap thereof.
