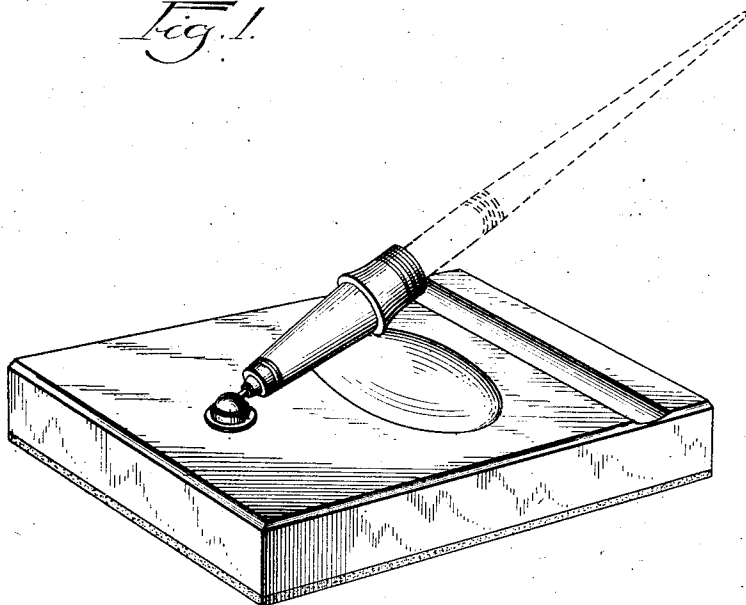
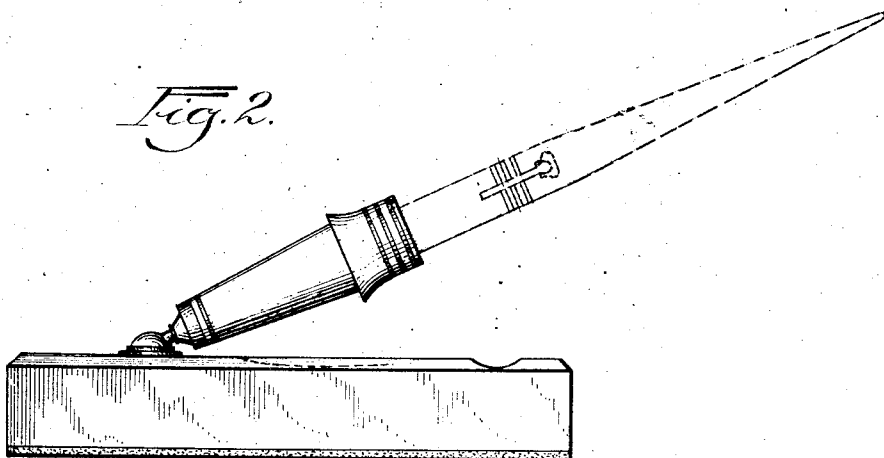

DESIGN FOR A COMBINED DESK STAND AND PENHOLDER.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that we, ROBERT BACK and GLENN A. COOPER, both citizens of the United States, residing at Chicago, in the county of Cook and State of Illinois, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for Combined Desk Stand and Penholder, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.
