To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Edward F. Molyneux, a citizen of the United States, residing in Westport, in the county of Fairfield, State of Connecticut, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Fountain Pen or Similar Article, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming a part thereof.

The figure is a front elevational view of a fountain pen showing my new design.

The dominant feature of my design is the ornamentation, substantially as shown, applied to fountain pens or similar articles.
