To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Farnham F. Boyle, a citizen of the United States, residing at Fort Madison, in the county of Lee and State of Iowa, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Fountain Pen or the like, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming a part thereof.

Figure 1 is a top plan view of a fountain pen or the like embodying my new design;

Fig. 2 is a side elevational view of a fountain pen which presents substantially the same appearance when viewed from any angle in elevation.

The dominant feature of my design resides in the cap shown in full lines.

I claim:

The ornamental design for a fountain pen or the like, substantially as shown and described.
