

DESIGN FOR A FOUNTAIN PEN OR SIMILAR ARTICLE

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Ray E. McKiernan, a citizen of the United States, residing at Fort Madison, in the county of Lee and State of Iowa, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Fountain Pen or Similar Article, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming a part thereof.

Figure 1 is a front elevational view of a fountain pen showing my new design;

Fig. 2 is a side elevational view of Fig. 1; and Fig. 3 is a rear elevational view of Fig. 1.

The dominant feature of my design resides in the contour of the clip member shown in full lines, the clip member conforming substantially to the contour of the end of the fountain pen and extending substantially equidistantly along both sides thereof.

I claim:

The ornamental design for a fountain pen or similar article, substantially as shown and described.
