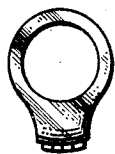

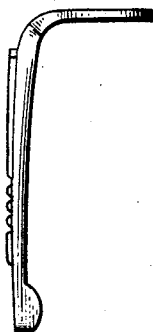

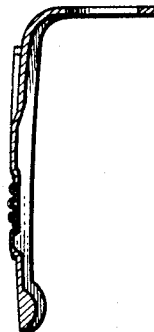

**DESIGN FOR A FOUNTAIN PEN AND PENCIL
CLIP OR THE LIKE**

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, David Kahn, a citizen of the United States, residing at Woodcliff, in the county of Hudson and State of New Jersey, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Fountain Pen and Pencil Clip or the Like, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing forming a part thereof, wherein:

Fig. 1 is a top plan view of a fountain pen and pencil clip showing my design.

Fig. 2 is a front elevational view thereof.

Fig. 3 is a side elevational view thereof.

Fig. 4 is a cross-sectional view thereof taken on the line 4—4 of Fig. 2.
