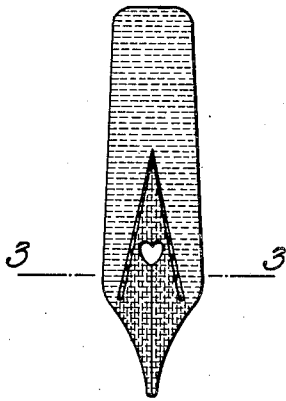

DESIGN FOR A PEN POINT

Max M. Neuhoff, New York, N. Y.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Max M. Neuhoff, a citizen of the United States, residing at New York, in the county of New York and State of New York, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Pen Point, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.

Figure 1 is a front elevational view of a pen point, showing my new design,

Figure 2 is a side elevational view thereof, and;

Figure 3 is a transverse sectional view taken substantially on the line 3—3 of Figure 1 of the same.

The drawing is lined for silver and gold, the main body portion of the point being silver and the forward portion being gold.
