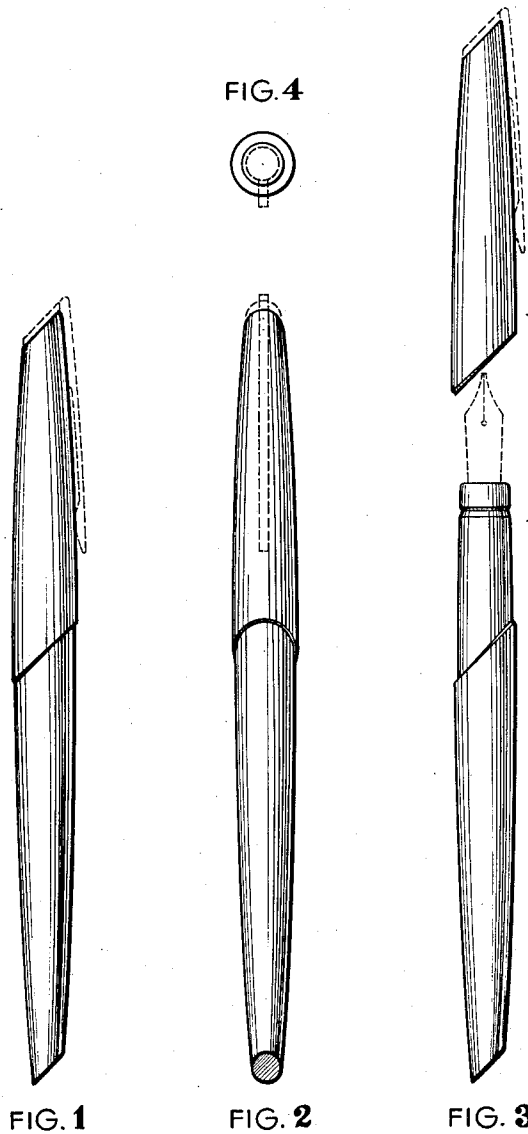


Fig. 1 is a side elevational view of a writing instrument according to my new design;
