



## DESIGN FOR A PEN AND PENCIL CLIP

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Leon Hehl Ashmore, a citizen of the United States of America and a resident of Collingswood, Camden County, New Jersey, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Pen and Pencil Clip, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming a part thereof.

Fig. 1 is a front elevation of the pen and pencil clip of my design.

Fig. 2 is a side elevation of the pen and pencil clip of my new design.

Fig. 3 is a plan view of the pen and pencil clip of my new design.

Fig. 4 is a sectional elevation taken on the line a-a, Fig. 1, of the pen and pencil clip of my new design.

Fig. 5 is a sectional view on the line b—b, Fig. 2. Fig. 6 is a sectional view on the line c-c, Fig. 1.

Fig. 7 is a sectional view on the line d-d, Fig. 1.

Fig. 8 is a sectional view on the line e-e, Fig. 1,

Fig. 9 is a sectional view on the line f—f, Fig. 1. I claim:

The ornamental design for a pen and pencil clip, substantially as shown.
