

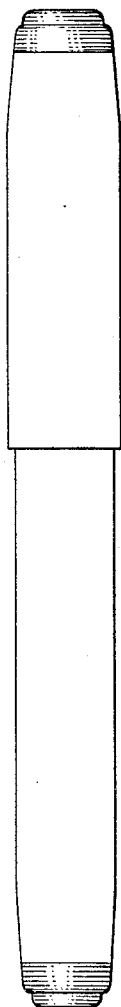

DESIGN FOR A FOUNTAIN PEN OR SIMILAR ARTICLE

Application filed February 16, 1931. Serial No. 38,684. Term of patent 14 years.

*To all whom it may concern:*

Be it known that I, GABRIEL LARSEN, a citizen of the United States, residing at Springfield, in the county of Union and State of New Jersey, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Fountain Pen or Similar Article, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming a part thereof.

This application is a continuation in part of my application for design for end of cap for fountain pen and the like, filed January 23, 1930, Serial No. D-34,242.

The figure is a longitudinal view of a fountain pen embodying the invention.

The pen and its cap are provided with ends of the form shown, which are slightly tapered lengthwise of the pen, and this taper is continued on to the pen and the cap, thereby giving the ends and portions adjacent thereto an appearance of smallness. The appearance of smallness may be further accentuated by making the ends of contrasting color with respect to the main portions of the pen and cap.

I claim:

The ornamental design for a fountain pen or similar article substantially as shown and described.
