

DESIGN FOR A PENCIL

William R. Cuthbert, Fort Madison, Iowa, assignor to W. A. Sheaffer Pen Company, Fort Madison, Iowa, a corporation of Delaware

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, William R. Cuthbert, a citizen of the United States, residing at Fort Madison, in the county of Lee and State of Iowa, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Pencil, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing forming a part thereof.

In the drawing:

Figure 1 is a front elevational view of a pencil embodying my new design, the pencil having a

tapered end and an elongated clip with the contour of the upper end of the clip conforming substantially with the tapered end of the pencil; and

Fig. 2 is a side elevational view of Figure 1 showing the upper end of the clip merging into the tapered end of the pencil.

I claim:
