

DESIGN FOR A FOUNTAIN PEN BARREL

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that we, Kenneth S. Parker, of Janesville, county of Rock, and State of Wisconsin, and Marlin S. Baker, of Janesville, county of Rock, and State of Wisconsin, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Fountain Pen Barrel, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming a part thereof.

In the drawing:

Fig. 1 is a side elevation of a fountain pen barrel showing our new design;

Fig. 2 is a top plan view of said fountain penbarrel; and

Fig. 3 is a bottom plan view of said fountain pen barrel.
