

DESIGN FOR A FOUNTAIN PEN

Ned D. Fish and Lynn P. Martin, Fort Madison, Iowa

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that we, Ned D. Fish and Lynn P. Martin, citizens of the United States, residing at Fort Madison, in the county of Lee and State of Iowa, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Fountain Pen, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming a part thereof.

Figure 1 is a side elevational view of a fountain pen embodying our new design, the cap of the fountain pen being disposed on the writing point end; and Fig. 2 is a front elevational view of Figure 1 showing the cap on the barrel end of the fountain pen with the writing point exposed.

This is a substitute for abandoned application D-116,369, filed November 17, 1944.

We claim:
