DESIGN FOR A CLIP FOR A FOUNTAIN PEN OR THE LIKE

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, ANDREAS BIENENSTEIN, a citizen of the United States of America, residing at Toledo, in the county of Lucas and State of Ohio, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for Clip for a Fountain Pen or the Like, and of which the following is a specification, reference being had therein to the accompanying drawings, forming a part thereof, wherein—

Figure 1 is a front elevation of a clip for a fountain pen showing my new design; and
