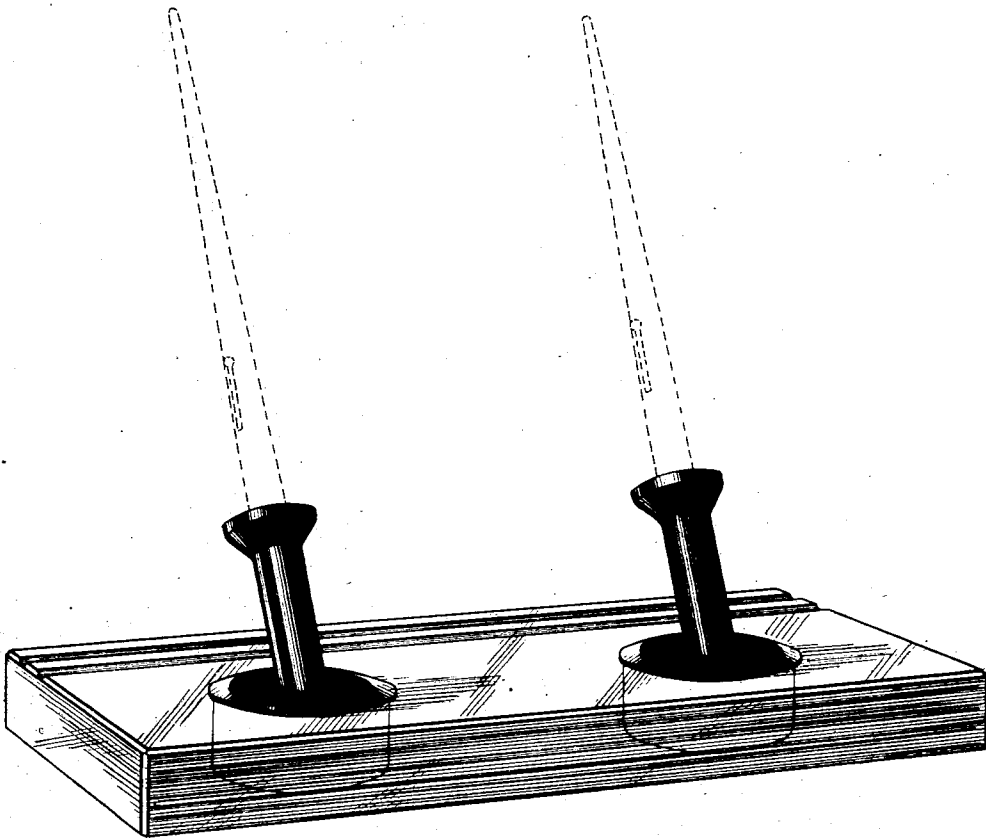

DESIGN FOR A FOUNTAIN-PEN DESK SET.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, FREDERICK D. HAMMONS, a citizen of the United States, residing at Seattle, in the county of King and State of Washington, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Fountain-Pen Desk Set, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming a part thereof.

The figure illustrates a perspective view of a fountain pen desk stand arranged to receive fountain pens, the pens being shown in dotted lines.
