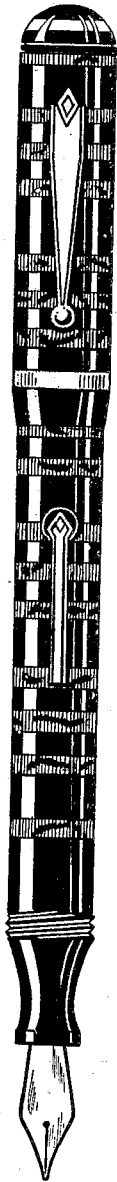

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Louis Morrison, a citizen of the United States, residing at 79 Fifth Avenue, in the county of New York and State of New York, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Fountain Pen or Similar Article, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof, in which

Fig. 1 is a front view in elevation of the foun-

tain pen in an open position, showing my new design; and

Fig. 2 is a front view in elevation of the same in a closed position.

The three bands at the top of the cap of the fountain pen indicate contrasting colors.
