To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that we, William Bowker, a citizen of the United States, residing at Newark, county of Essex, State of New Jersey, and Rene P. Piperoux, a citizen of the United States, residing at Radburn, in the county of Bergen, State of New Jersey, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for Fountain Pens, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.

The ornamentation of the fountain pen shown

on the drawing comprises alternating strata presenting colored and pearl effects.
