To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Kenneth S. Parker, a citizen of the United States and a resident of Janesville, in the county of Rock and State of Wisconsin, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Fountain Pen or Other Writing Implement, of which the following is a specification, reference being had therein to the accompanying drawing, forming a part thereof, wherein

Figs. 1 and 2 are elevational views, taken at right angles from each other, showing my new design.

The dominant feature of my design for a fountain pen resides in the type of ornamentation shown thereon.

It is to be understood that my design may be embodied in such articles as fountain pens and mechanical pencils without departing from the spirit of the invention.

I claim:

The ornamental design for a fountain pen or other writing implement substantially as shown and described.
