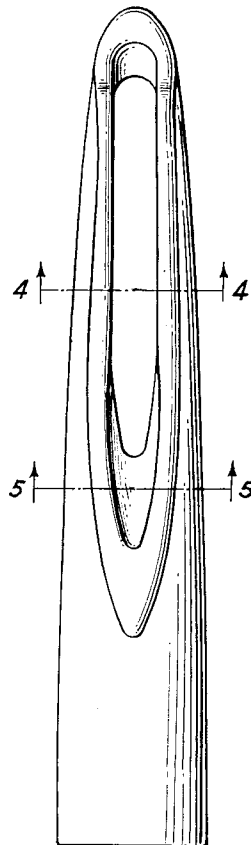

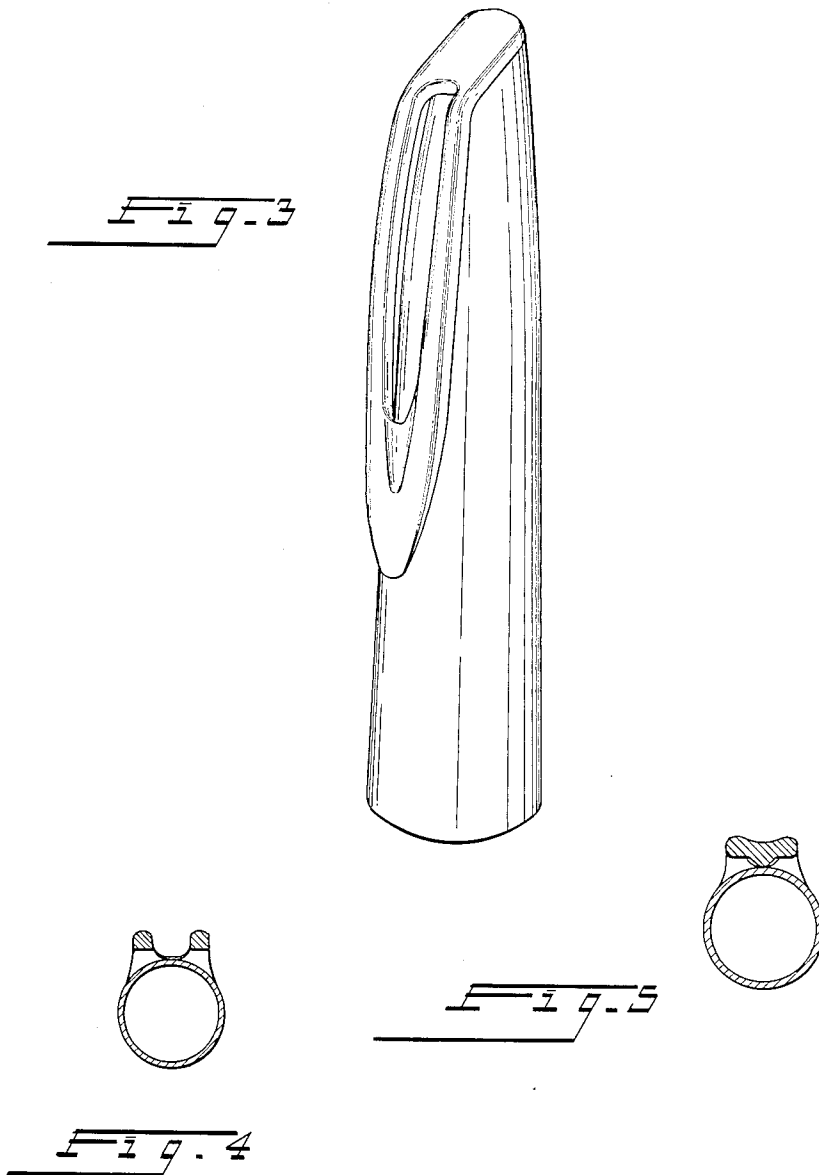


Figure 1 is a side elevational view of a cap for a writing instrument, showing our new design;
