

## DESIGN FOR A FOUNTAIN PEN

Norman E. Weigel, Short Hills, N. J.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Norman E. Weigel, a citizen of the United States and a resident of Short Hills, in the county of Essex and State of New Jersey, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Fountain Pen, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.

Figure 1 is a side elevational view of a fountain pen showing my new design and with the cap removed from the writing end of the pen barrel and attached to the other end thereof.

Figure 2 is a top plan view of the fountain pen. Figure 3 is a bottom plan view thereof.

Figure 4 is a side elevational view of the fountain pen with the cap attached to the writing end of the pen.
