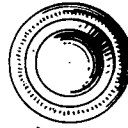
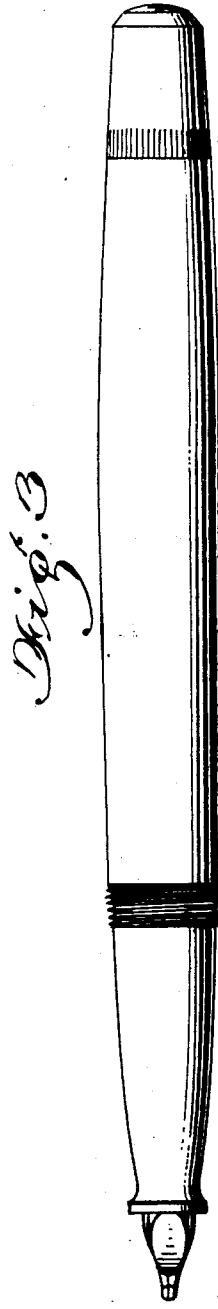
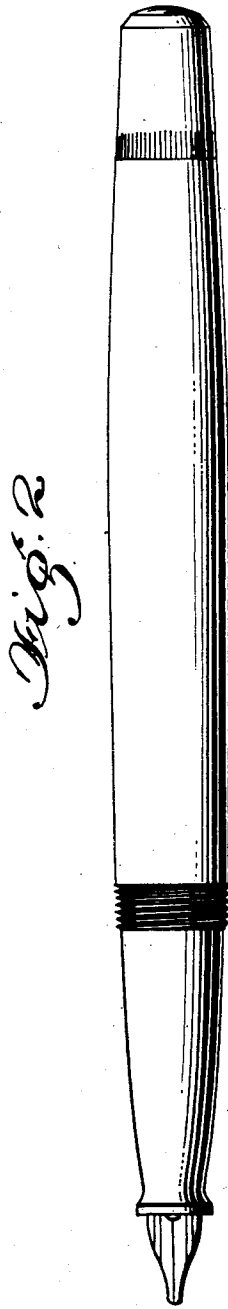
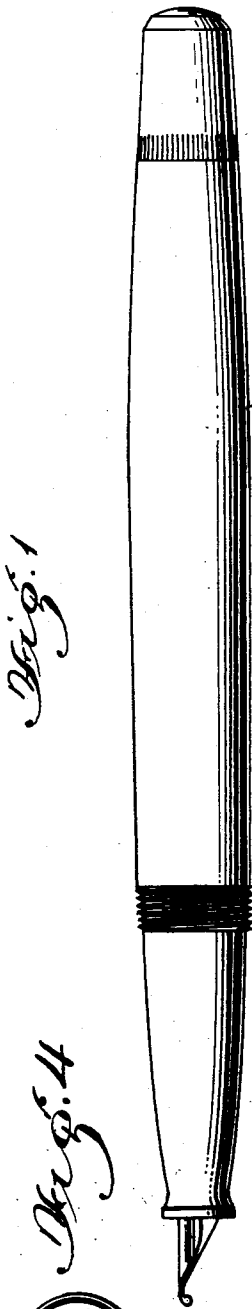

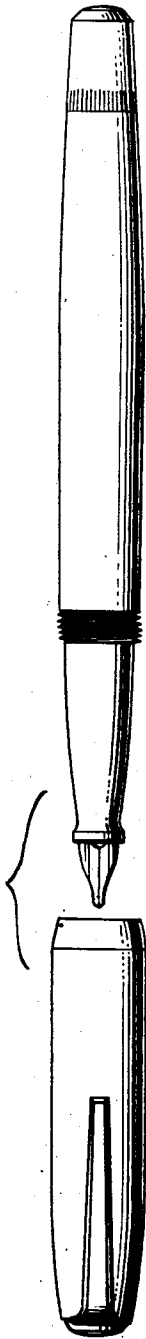

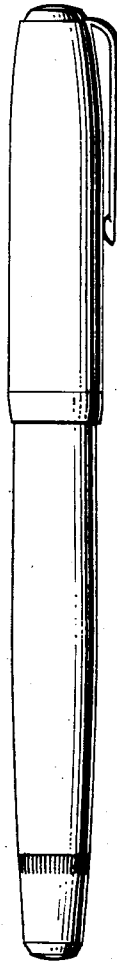

DESIGN FOR A FOUNTAIN PEN

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, David Kahn, a citizen of the United States, residing at Englewood, in the county of Bergen and State of New Jersey, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Fountain Pen, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawings, forming a part thereof, wherein:

Figure 1 is a side elevational view of a fountain pen barrel showing my new design;

Figure 2 is an elevational view taken at right angles to the view in Figure 1;

Figure 3 is an elevational view of the underside of the pen shown in Figure 2;

Figure 4 is an end view taken from the writing point end;

Figure 5 is a top view of the upper end of the barrel;

Figure 6 is an exploded view showing the fountain pen barrel assembled with the cap member;

Figure 7 is a side view of the fountain pen showing the cap member assembled upon the upper end of the barrel member;

Figure 8 is a side elevational view of the complete fountain pen in a closed position; and

Figure 9 is a top plan view of the fountain pen with the cap in its assembled closed position.

I claim:

The ornamental design for a fountain pen, as shown and described.
